

FFA Enrichment Center at DMACC Opens

The FFA Enrichment Center in Prairie Trail on the Ankeny Campus of Des Moines Area Community College (DMACC) opened this month. The 57,000 square foot Center is a partnership between DMACC, Future Farmers of America (FFA), DRA Properties and the City of Ankeny. The opening of the center marks another increase in the level of business amenities in Ankeny.

The Enrichment Center will give businesses and organizations additional options for hosting meetings and conferences. The building features an 8,000 square foot, two-story exhibit hall and a nearly 24,000 square foot conference center with six breakout rooms. The conference center has a capacity to serve up to 500 people.

The Enrichment Center serves as the state headquarters for the Iowa FFA Foundation and the leadership center for the Iowa FFA Chapter. It is designed to enhance agriculture-focused education and business in the state. The Center is also home to DMACC's Agri-business and Veterinary Technician education programs. Together the programs have more than 200 students on the Ankeny campus.
